FAIR HOUSING COMMITMENT



WHEREAS, our social fabric, the economy, health, and environment are strengthened in diverse, inclusive communities; and

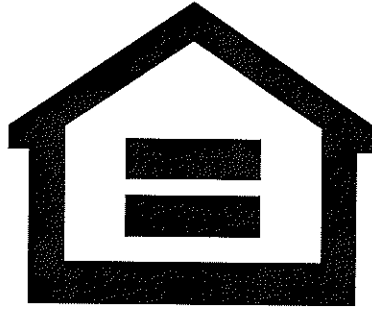

Resolution to Adopt a Fair Housing Ordinance

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE SECTION 32 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE
OF THE VILLAGE OF WHITE LAKE
ADOPTING WISCONSIN STATUTES, SECTION 106.50, AS AMENDED,
RELATING TO THE EQUAL RIGHTS OF ALL PERSONS TO FAIR HOUSING, AND
PROVIDING MEANS FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION AND ENFORCEMENT THEREOF.

THE VILLAGE OF WHITE LAKE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 01 is created to read as follows:

FAIR AND OPEN HOUSING

WHEREAS, the Village of the White Lake recognizes its responsibilities under Section 106.50, Wisconsin Statutes, as amended, and endorses the concepts of fair and open housing for all persons and prohibition of discrimination therein;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED THAT:

- 1) The Village of the White Lake hereby adopts Section 106.50, Wisconsin Statutes, as amended, and all subsequent amendments thereto.
- 2) The officials and employees of the Village shall assist in the orderly prevention and removal of all discrimination in housing within the Village of White Lake, Langlade County, Wisconsin by implementing the authority and enforcement procedures set forth in Section 106.50, Wisconsin Statutes, as amended.
- 3) The Municipal Clerk shall maintain forms for complaints to be filed under Section 106.50, Wisconsin Statutes, as amended, and shall assist any person alleging a violation thereof in the Village to file a complaint thereunder with the Wisconsin Department of Work Force Development, Equal Rights Division, for enforcement of Section 106.50, Wisconsin Statutes, as amended.
