- MSA Project Updates-Tom Edelman-A FEMA Grant just became available that could qualify to get a generator for the community center building and the fire department.

**New Business**

- Deputy Travis Krueger-Langlade County Emergency Management Director came to introduce himself to the board and talk a bit about his role.
- Discussion on emergency siren at the community center. It is getting out dated and the best way to inform the public of a weather emergency. Deputy Krueger reminded the board about the free "everbridge" system that the county has. Anyone can join the alert system which will alert landlines by an automated call, cell phones by a text or call and sent emails. Robbins Sport Flooring still sets off their whistle, Clerk Blawat will get info on if the mill uses it during all weather emergencies and also check on how much the insurance is for our current siren at the community center. During the fire departments March meeting they seen no reason to keep it in use. The Village will start to get the word out about "everbridge".
- MSA Contract Amendment #1 to the park project was presented to the board. A motion was made by Listle/Skarlupka to amend the MSA Professional Services CDBG-CV 2022 Park Improvement Project agreement from March 8, 2022 to add additional fees for work done on: WDNR permit review, alternate restroom proposal, & state building and permit coordination in the total amount of \$8,921.54; All Ayes, Motion Carried.
